

Sunday, 2 March 2014In the morning we got on the bus and went to Brasov.






This old town is very famous for the Bran Castle where, according to the legend, the count Dracula lived in. The castle is very nice and very well equipped by the original pieces of furniture.


The students had some question about the Voinesti town and its people and facilites and the major was so kind to them that he answered all the questions and because our students made an impression on him....

....and then we continued to Bucharest, the capital city. In the city we went on the guided tour to see the People's house











And then we had some private time to see the capital.....


















Week II


Monday, 10 March 2014
